D12 Monthly Focus for September: *Values being guided by the Word of God.*

1. Opening Prayer

- Share prayer requests
- Pray together (thank God for something, pray for others, and pray for self)

Recite the Do Something Disciple Prayer

“As a Do Something Disciple, I am in a disciplined pursuit for the heart of The Father, a heart that is being perfected in love for God and people.

Father give me a heart that:

- Desperately seeks face-to-face intimacy with You.
- Faithfully avoids that which displeases You.
- Humbly embraces a Kingdom Mindset.
- Values making disciples that make disciples.

Jesus, create in me a heart that:

- Values being guided by the Word of God.
- Gratefully grows in generosity.
- Nurtures a burden for lost people.
- Demonstrates a commitment to a Spirit-filled expression of my gifts.

Holy Spirit develop a heart in me that:

- Gracefully gives and receives forgiveness.
- Passionately worships God.
- Is dependent on the power of prayer.
- Serves with Humility.

"Father, with Christlikeness as my goal and the Holy Spirit as my Guide, knit my heart with Yours. Fill my heart with Your passions, motivations, and desires.

In Jesus' Name, Amen."

2. Review

- **Monthly Memory Verse: Malachi 3:8 (NKJV):** *“Will a man rob God? Yet you have robbed Me! But you say, ‘In what way have we robbed You?’ In tithes and offerings.”*
 - Try to share the verse by memory
- **Monthly D12 Attribute:** *Values being guided by the Word of God.*
 - Share how you are applying it in your life.

3. Discussion Time

- Begin with key insights from your daily journal and allow the Holy Spirit to guide your discussion.
 - What is the Holy Spirit teaching or revealing to you?
 - What is a current challenge you are dealing with?
 - What step will you take to be more obedient to him?
 - What help do you need?
 - Who will you share your faith with this week?

4. Review the Sunday Sermon notes

On Sunday at the Point Loma campus, Pastor Travis opened his message by letting us know that being called to more isn't about possessions, but having a lifestyle that God has called us to live. He then shared a story about the types of phone calls that he receives. The first call was one he received when he was working out at the gym. The contact on his cell phone read, “Telemarketer”. He did not pick up that call. But he did share that calls from his wife are always received. He even talked about calls that he never picks up from “Do not answer,” because the person on the other end always causes him drama.

Finally, he stated that in life you will get calls from everywhere and everybody but the one that you decide to answer is what matters. We need to answer the call that God has placed on our lives.
