Monthly Discipleship Focus for April: Serve with Humility

In this message, Pastor Miles talked about restarting our relationship with the Lord and with the church. In order to serve well, we need to have the mind of a servant. And in order to have the mind of a true servant, we need to have the mind of Christ! Over the next 3 weeks, we will be looking closely at the humility of Jesus as we serve to secure the glory of God.

As a group, read through the scriptures regarding servanthood then answer the questions that follow:

- Abraham: Genesis 18:3 “My Lord, if I have now found favor in Your sight, do not pass on by Your servant.”
- Isaac: Genesis 24:14 “*Let her be the one* You have appointed for Your servant Isaac.”
- Jacob: Genesis 32:10 “I am not worthy of the least of all the mercies and of all the truth which You have shown Your servant; for I crossed over this Jordan with my staff, and now I have become two companies.”
- Moses: Numbers 12:7 “Not so with My servant Moses; He *is* faithful in all My house.”
- Joshua: Judges 2:8 “Now Joshua the son of Nun, the servant of the LORD, died *when he was* one hundred and ten years old.”
- David: 2 Samuel 7:5 “Go and tell My servant David, ‘Thus says the LORD: “Would you build a house for Me to dwell in?”’
- Solomon: 1 Kings 1:14 “Then, while you are still talking there with the king, I also will come in after you and confirm your words.”
- Jesus: Mark 10:42-47 “But Jesus called them to *Himself* and said to them, “You know that those who are considered rulers over the Gentiles lord it over them, and their great ones exercise authority over them. Yet it shall not be so among you; but whoever desires to become great among you shall be your servant. And whoever of you desires to be first shall be slave of all. For even the Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve, and to give His life a ransom for many.”

Philippians 2:11

“*that every tongue should confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.*”

1. What are the **POWERS** that make you a somebody? Philippians 2:6

What are some things in your life that make you feel important (your education, skill, personality, looks, and more)?

2. How can you **SUBMIT** like a nobody? Philippians 2:8

Don't let your accolades lead your actions. What are some ways you can set aside those things you listed above in order to serve others better?

3. How can you **LOOK LIKE** a nobody? Philippians 2:8, Isaiah 52:13 – 53:3

What are some circumstances that happened in your life that have caused others to look at you in a more positive light because of how you responded?

4. How can you **HELP** like a nobody? Philippians 2:3-4

Give an example or two on how you can leverage your strengths to help someone else.
