Sermon Application Questions from Sunday's Message:

Pastor Greg opened up by talking about how God was speaking to him about working on his RAS. RAS stands for reticular activating system. This is a system in your brain which allows you to see things more frequently.

He prompted us to remember that God wants to give us greater ability to see Him more frequently. He encouraged us to receive more and to want more for our lives... see joy, have fervor, and embrace encounters with God.

Discuss the following statements in your rGroup regarding ways that God speaks:

- Read Ezekiel 37:1-4. Ezekiel went from being a priest to a prophet and stepped into the 'more' on behalf of the people of Israel.
 1. Obedience in Christ reveals true purpose for your life. A simple application to this could be serving in a ministry. Are you currently serving at the Rock Church? Why or why not?
 2. God created and commissioned you to 'release life to people and environments. Who are you encouraging with the Gospel of Jesus? What are the environments that God has placed you in to influence for His will?
 3. God created your life not to be ordinary, but to reflect HIS extraordinary. Are you living out the will of God in your life? Do you know your spiritual gifts? Are you living an extraordinary life?
 4. God created you to engage in all of His will for your life. Are you doing what God has called you to do? Are you living Your life for Christ? How can you engage more of God's will in your life?
