Sermon Application Questions from Sunday's Message:

Pastor Travis opened up for all of the pastors by encouraging everyone to want more from God. He then introduced 4 of the Rock Youth Pastors from our campuses, who then shared about "MORE" in relationship to God. Specifically, they discussed being commissioned for "MORE".

For Discussion:

- Pastor Phil from East County shared from the book of Jonah. As a group, read Jonah 3:1-3 together. Discuss the following statements and their meaning:
 - God is inviting us to arise and step into the life that He is calling us into.
 - God has commissioned us to go into the mission that He wants us to do.
 - God is the God of second chances.
- Pastor Ty from City Heights shared from the book of Hosea. He specifically shared about Hosea's relationship with Gomer. As a group, read Hosea 1 together. Discuss the following statements and their meaning:
 - Recognize that God wants more of your life.
 - There are people whose faith is dependent on your obedience.
- Pastor Jake from our San Ysidro campus shared from the book of Jonah. As a group, read Jonah 1:14-17 then discuss the following statements and their meaning:
 - God knows where you are.
 - God knows where He wants to take you.
 - God will provide a way for you to get there.
- Pastor Allison from our Point Loma campus shared from the book of Joel. As a group, read Joel 2:3. Discuss the following:
 - Change your focus.
 - Live with the future in mind.
 - Speak to the more in others.
