And it’s proven at this time by how we love people who don’t vote like us. To love those who don’t vote like you, LABEL everyone your neighbor, PRIORITIZE the expansion of God’s Kingdom, not man’s empire, and PLACE the needs of the other person first. Our faith, not political view, needs to be what unites us together.
