## D12 Monthly Focus for November: Gratefully Grows in Generosity

### 1. Opening Prayer

- Pray together (thank God for something, pray for others, and pray for self)

#### Recite the Difference Maker's Prayer

“As a Difference-Making Disciple, I am pursuing the heart of the Father, a heart that is being perfected in love for God and people.

Father, give me a heart that:

- Desperately seeks face-to-face intimacy with You.
- Gracefully gives and receives forgiveness.
- Nurtures a burden for lost people.
- Serves with humility.

Jesus, create in me a heart that:

- Demonstrates a commitment to a Spirit-filled expression of my gifts.
- Faithfully avoids that which distracts me from obeying You.
- Humbly embraces a kingdom mindset.
- Values making disciples that multiply.

Holy Spirit, develop a heart in me that:

- Values being guided by the Word of God.
- Is dependent on the power of prayer.
- Gratefully grows in generosity.
- Passionately worships the fullness of God.

Father, with Christlikeness as my goal and the Holy Spirit as my Guide, knit my heart with Yours. Fill my heart with Your love for all people. In Jesus' Name, Amen.”

## 4. Review the Sunday Sermon notes

Pastor Miles wrapped up his current series on “Red or Blue – What Would Jesus Do?” He began talking about the election and how people are now showing their true colors. People who say, “I believe in Jesus,” believe in the Bible, and claim He is the Savior, should be more comfortable with people who share similar faith but separate political views, versus those who have a similar political view but different faith. And it's proven at this time by how we love people who don't vote like us. To love those who don't vote like you, LABEL everyone your neighbor, PRIORITIZE the expansion of God's Kingdom, not man's empire, and PLACE the needs of the other person first. Our faith, not political view, needs to be what unites us together.
