D12 Monthly Focus for October: Is Dependent On the Power of Prayer

Sermon Application from Sunday's Message:

Pastor Miles continued his series on “Red or Blue – What Would Jesus Do?”. As we confess our inadequacies, offenses, and needs to God, we should be encouraged that Jesus is sufficient in every situation. As we understand this truth and accept it in our hearts, we need to be an encouragement to others through these difficult times.

As a group, read through the following statements and discuss the questions below:

1. I admit my **INADEQUACY**, which is fulfilled by Christ. – Isaiah 6:1-5
 - In these verses we see that Isaiah is having a divine encounter with God in the throne-room of heaven.
 - How does Christ fulfill us when we feel inadequate?
2. I admit my **OFFENSES**, which are forgiven by Christ. 1 John 1:8-10
 - As we confess our sins to God we need to know that we are forgiven by Jesus.
 - Take some time in your group to confess your sins to yourself and to God. Then spend some time in prayer and ask for the Holy Spirit to speak to you. What is the Holy Spirit saying to you?
3. I admit my **NEED**, which is fulfilled by Christ. Philippians 4:13
 - Despite our needs and circumstances, we should be encouraged that Christ is all sufficient for our lives.
 - What needs to you currently have? Discuss how we can endure any need in this life through Christ's empowerment.
