Recite the Do Something Disciple Prayer

Sermon Application from Sunday's Message:

On Sunday 3/15, Pastor Miles addressed the church regarding the coronavirus and how we can respond as a church to take "CARE" of ourselves and others. Pastor Miles gave a message of hope and referenced 1 Timothy 1:7, concentrating on the importance of using our spiritual power, love, and having a sound mind through this season. Finally, Pastor Miles interviewed three public officials asking them questions about the coronavirus and how we should respond. Those officials were Dr. Wilma Wooten from the San Diego Public Health Department, Bill Wells, the Mayor of El Cajon, and Kevin Faulconer, the Mayor of San Diego.

Take time to read through the following materials in your rGroup and discuss the questions provided.

- Read 2 Timothy 1:3-7. In these verses Paul is sharing an encouragement for his young disciple Timothy. Timothy was leading a church in Ephesus. Timothy was timid and he was facing opposition in his church. In verse 7 Paul specifically encourages Timothy by writing him “For God has not given us a spirit of fear, but of power and of love and of a sound mind.”
 - Power defined by Pastor Miles is the ability to exert the spiritual force necessary for change.
 - As a group take 15 minutes and use the power of prayer to pray for God’s presence, healing for the world both physical and spiritually. Encourage each other to pray with the church in the ongoing 24 hours of prayer.
 - Love as defined by Pastor Miles is affection toward God and others.
 - As a group discuss ways that you can love others in the community. San Diego Mayor Falconer suggested that if you have an elderly neighbor that needs assistance pick up groceries and supplies from the store for them so that they are not exposed to the virus. As a group think of some other ways that you can help people that are most vulnerable to the virus.
 - Having a sound mind was defined as someone who is sensible, intelligent, and makes reasonable decisions.
 - As a group discuss what adjustments you will need to make in your lives to keep yourself and others healthy during this season. Text COVID to 52525 for ideas.
